Our Chairman, Eric Stuart-Bamford, Esquire, invites you to join him on a guided tour of Freemasons' Hall and Museum. Freemasons' Hall is the headquarters of the United Grand Lodge of England and the principal meeting place for Masonic Lodges in London. Grand Lodge has been in Great Queen Street since 1775, the present Hall being the third building on the site. Built between 1927-1932 as a memorial to the Freemasons who died in the First World War, it is one of the finest Art Deco buildings in England, and is now Grade II* listed internally and externally. In addition to the Grand Temple (seating 1700) there are 21 Lodge Rooms, a Library and Museum, Board and Committee Rooms and administrative offices.

After the visit we will take lunch in the Hardy & Tennyson Suite of the four-star Kingsway Hall Hotel, situated close by Freemasons' Hall. **Please make your choice from the menu:**

Starter: (A) Tartlet of Wild Mushrooms, Quail's Egg, Sauce Hollandaise or (B) Jerusalem Artichoke Soup, Chive Oil

Main Course: (C) Grilled Salmon, Crushed New Potatoes, Ratatouille, Green Pesto or (D) Aubergine and Spinach Raviolini, Sage Butter Sauce (Vegetarian).

Dessert: (E) Lemon Tart & Raspberry Sorbet or (F) Fruit Salad, with or without cream or a scoop of ice cream or (G) Cheese and Biscuits

The price includes half a bottle of wine per person to be served with the meal. Members and their guests will have the opportunity to purchase pre-prandial drinks, should they wish.
