The beautiful church of St Margaret Lothbury, as well as being the Church of the two Ward Clubs, is also the home church of other civic organisations and livery companies. Inspirational informal services are held on Wednesday lunchtimes and special services are held throughout the year, including our own Harvest Festivals and Carol Services. There has been a church on the site since the twelfth century, but the present church was completed in 1692, being rebuilt after the fire of London to the design of Sir Christopher Wren, with the addition of Robert Hooke's tower in 1700. The church now contains furniture and fittings from other Wren churches, most notably the splendid choir screen that stood originally in the Church of all Hallows the Great, Thames Street, now demolished.

Our friends and neighbours at Broad Street Ward Club have arranged for our mutual enjoyment a relaxed party in the garden of the Church, at which wine, soft drinks and summer canapés will be served. As an additional, not-to-be-missed attraction, the Rector has indicated that he is prepared to show members and their guests round the Church itself. The magnificent choir screen, the high altar reredos, the pulpit and baptismal font, the paintings and monuments are all worthy of note, not to mention the church-plate dating from the sixteenth to the nineteenth centuries.

We hope that you will enjoy this special evening in our own City Church, and our Chairman, Nigel James, Esquire, looks forward to welcoming you and your guests to what we are sure will be a very special occasion..
