Our Chairman, Eric Stuart-Bamford, Esquire, invites you to join him in enjoying the spectacular views from the iconic Shard building and afterwards to take supper at the George Inn in nearby Borough High Street.

Designed by the Italian architect Renzo Piano and standing approximately 310 metres (1,020 ft) high, the Shard is currently the tallest building in the European Union. The glass-clad pyramidal tower has 72 habitable floors. We shall visit the viewing gallery and observation deck on the 72nd floor, at a height of 244.3 metres (802 ft). We will meet at 6.15PM at the Ticket Office for the View for the Shard located in Joiner Street. We have been allocated a fixed time slot for entry at 6.30 PM so **prompt arrival is essential**.

At approximately 8.00PM we will gather for supper in the Winchester Room of the George Inn. Established in the Middle Ages and currently owned and leased by the National Trust, the George is the only surviving galleried coaching inn in London. **Please make your choice from the menu:**

Starter: (A) Loch Fyne Smoked Salmon with multigrain bread or (B) Vegetable Soup and roll

Main Course: (C) Chicken Supreme with Mushroom Sauce or (D) Sea Bass Fillets with herb butter or (E) Mushroom & Thyme Tagliatelle (Vegetarian). Main courses served with vegetables.

Dessert: (F) Seasonal Fruit Crumble with Custard or (G) Fresh Fruit Salad
