Rifle Shooting and Lunch at Bisley Camp

9.00AM for 9.30AAM Saturday, 1 June 2013

Our Chairman, Eric Stuart-Bamford, Esquire, invites you to join him for a morning's shooting followed by lunch at Bisley Camp, the British National Shooting Centre, and for over 100 years the home of the National Rifle Association, the governing body of full-bore rifle and pistol shooting in the UK. Many of you will be aware that our Chairman is himself a crack marksman, having taken part in shooting competitions at international level on many occasions. Under one-to-one guidance you will have the opportunity of shooting a mixture of weapons and calibers, 7.62 Target Rifles, .303 SMLE and No4 Service Rifles, and also telescopic-sighted rifles.

To experience Bisley Camp is to enter a Victorian or Edwardian time-warp, many of the buildings having been built as shooting huts shortly after the camp was completed in 1890 or transported there from the previous camp on Wimbledon Common. We will enjoy the privilege of lunching in one such hut, The Artists Rifles Clubhouse, situated on Club Row at Bisley, where we shall also meet in the morning. The Artists Rifles was one of the original Yeomanry Units formed in 1860. They were rebadged in 1947 as 21 SAS and are still playing their part in the defence of the Realm today.

Cost of the event:

1. Rifle Shoot and Lunch: £36.50 per person
2. Rifle Shoot only: £11 per person
3. Lunch only: £25.50 per person

Closing date for applications: 16 May 2013 to enable the names of those attending to be submitted to the police as per Home Office guidelines.
